Once again I share insights from Fran Salone-Pelletier in [Awakening to God, The Sunday Readings in Our Lives](#), from Twenty-Third Publications. She has a most unique way of helping us to see Christ in those around us. Keep your eyes -- and heart -- open to see Christ in others -- every day!

### Humble Hearts and Gentle People

Can't you just hear God humming that dear old song, "I love those humble hearts and gentle people that live in my hometown"? There's a picture in my head of a smiling deity, warmed by the presence of the people called to be God's own, living in God's hometown. I can see God rejoicing heartily with the daughters and sons of divinity as they shout for joy that God is in their midst. I can imagine all of us being surprised that the God who is among us is a God who treasures humility and reveals truth to those who are open to hear it.

Humble hearts are found in gentle people who have taken residence in God's hometown.

If humble persons are those who are akin to the earth, they are basic to existence. Found everywhere, they are essential to growth and development. They are

the foundation upon which gardens prosper. They give stability to what would otherwise be a sea of chaotic motion. Their consciousness of shortcomings and defects opens the way to transformation and recognition that perfection is always in the making. Not to be self-assertive, as the earth does not impose itself upon us, is to have a centrality that does not revolve around being the center. I guess one could say that humble people are like the holes in doughnuts. Unseen, they create the reality about them and keep it intact. Knowing that being oneself is the only authentic authority, humble persons are true leaders. ...

... These are ... people who would not stand out in a crowd nor attain position or rank. But they represent those who are the earth upon which we stand. Quietly solid in their commitments, these humble folks maintain the meaning of gentleness and give credence to the power of humility.

... In their constancy and compassionate caring, they exemplify for all of us Christ's call: "Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest" (*Mt 11:28*). With their labor and

## BAPTISMAL PREPARATION SESSION

**TODAY, Sunday, July 9 at 12:15pm in the parlor.**

Baptismal preparation sessions are scheduled 6 times/year (Jan-Mar-May-Jul-Sep-Nov) and parents need to attend a session before scheduling the Baptism.

Godparents are to help the parents as they raise their child in the Catholic faith, so godparents are to be Catholic, and there is to be one male and one female godparent.

*Families need to be registered members of the parish. It is our hope that they regularly participate at Mass, considering themselves to be members of the parish community.*

Baptisms are normally celebrated on the fourth weekend of the month. Parents are to attend a Baptismal session prior to their child's Baptism. The preparation session offers an opportunity to discuss the Sacrament of Baptism in the life of this child. It is not simply a "rehearsal" of the rite itself.

*For this week, let's ponder this idea:*

Jesus reads the Scriptures only one time in the gospels, and he does it in the context of a liturgy. In the synagogue of Nazareth, in the midst of the assembly gathered in prayer for the Sabbath, Jesus reads the prophecy of Isaiah and comments on it (cf. Luke 4: 16 – 21).

According to the gospel texts, those who gathered in the synagogue were the only people ever to have seen and heard Jesus read the Scriptures aloud in a liturgical assembly. How blessed these people to have heard with their own ears **the Word reading Scripture!**

*Imagine being present in the synagogue that day and then imagine reflecting on the experience after the resurrection!*
