"Be still, and know that I am God." Ps 46: 10

Be stilled my spirit in quiet and peace
 Slow my pace in solace without cease.
 Let my silence be deep and wide
 So God might be allowed to creep inside.
 All noise and turmoil banished be
 Leaving only God and me
 To walk upon the waters of life
 With nary a fear of drowning in strife.
 Be still, be still, be still, and know
 The God from whom my goodness flows. Amen.

This short prayer is offered to us by Fran Salone-Pelletier in Awakening to God, Year A, The Sunday Readings in Our Lives. The author appeals to us to be open to 'Entering the World of A Whispering God' in this week's Gospel from Matthew. She reminds us that God does not

dwell in chaotic confusion but in compassionate creativity. She says, "When I let the noise pass by -- and I do have to allow its passage and not ignore it -- then I can hear the whisper of divinity. I can leave the confines of my caved life and enter the world of a whispering God."

She continues..."Jesus of Nazareth knew the wisdom of that movement and often went off by himself to pray. He left the crowds that were encasing him. ... So he removed himself -- and sought the world of a whispering God."

..."It was good for him to be alone in prayer with God, his beloved Abba whose mission he was determined to fulfill."

"In the wonder and mystery of this prayerful intimacy, Jesus was refreshed, renewed, and ready to return to his companions in the boat that was 'battered by

the waves, was far from the land, for the wind was against them (Mt 14: 24). Jesus' prayerfulness empowered him to rise above the tumult, to walk on the waves of fear that were engulfing his friends."

"Yet they were fearful. Jesus tenderly soothed and reassured them. Using what they knew and assured of His constant presence, He urged them, 'Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid' (Mt 14: 27). The presence of God is deep within our spirit."

I share this prayer and reflection with you to comfort you after last weekend's tragic accident in our Scouting community. We may feel "the winds of time and change, the waves of fear engulfing friends. We are not alone. Our Creator is too busy inviting us to enter the wonderful world of a whispering God."

"Be still, and know that I am God."

We will continually be challenged to rely on our faith. We can expect there to be noise and confusion. I pray that you will trust God to calm your nerves, to ease your pain during this time. Your example of faith trusted and lived will be important in your family.

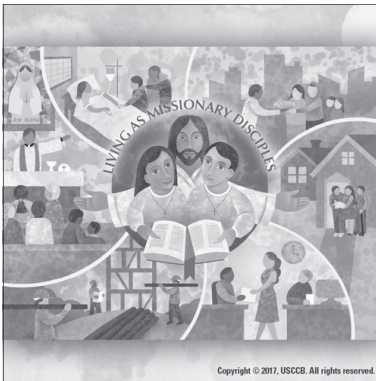

**THE SPIRITUAL MEANING
OF THE LITURGY**

Words of Wisdom to Ponder from the Book
by Goffredo Boselli ... Liturgical Press, Collegeville, MN, ©2014

*Today we reflect on "Mystagogy
of the Liturgy of the Word"*

*In continuing our reflection on the "Mystagogy of the
Liturgy of the Word," we look at "The Book of the
Scriptures." We share part of page 59...*

As called for by the synagogue rite,
the scroll is handed to the lector Jesus so that he may
read it before the community.
The attendant puts it into his hands because it is not the
property of the lector.

That is also why we see that Jesus, on finishing the
reading, "rolled up the scroll [and] gave it back to the
attendant" (Luke 4: 20).

The scroll is not his but the community's.
He has received it from the community
and he returns it to the community.

The community is its authorized caretaker.
Similarly, in the Christians' liturgical assembly,
the lector receives from the church the book
of canonical texts to read.

It is not the lector's but the church's.
By placing it on the ambo, the church puts it
into the lector's hands.

On finishing the reading, the lector does not carry the
book away but leaves it with the assembly,
because it is in the assembly's care,
just as the Eucharist is.
